

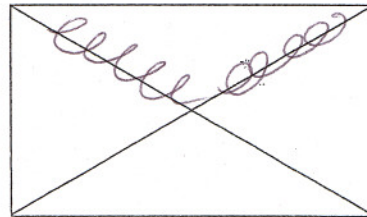
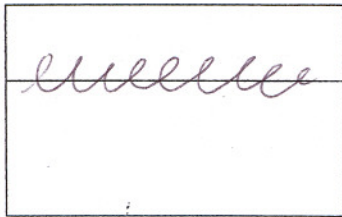
## ABSENTEE BALLOT

Your Absentee Ballot must be **received** by the CCCSB prior to the date of the conversion election. If you are sending your Absentee Ballot by mail, you should mail the Ballot seven (7) business days prior to the date of the conversion election to ensure that the ballot is received by the CCCSB prior to the election. If you choose, you may submit your ballot to the CCCSB on the date and time of the election.

You may submit your Absentee Ballot by mail or personal hand-delivery to the D.C. Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, at 941 North Capitol Street, N.E., Suite 7100, Washington, D.C. 20002 or you may submit it to a person designated by the Tenant Organization to collect and submit Absentee Ballots.

**All absentee ballot envelopes must have your signature on the seal of the envelope and will be opened only by the CCCSB.**
