



## **J&C Joins in Hurricane Katrina Relief Effort**

*September, 2005* – In response to the national recovery efforts to aid individuals and businesses that have been devastated by Hurricane Katrina in the Gulf Coast, Jackson & Campbell initiated its own collection program. To jump-start the firm effort, the Executive Committee authorized a firm contribution of \$1,500, and promised J&C employees that they would match any individual contributions (up to a maximum of \$5,000).

Following the firm's generous example, J&C attorneys and staff members were quick to make their individual contributions. Many chose to donate to the American Red Cross. Others chose to make their donations to a favorite charity or church group. Within one week, J&C individual contributions exceeded the firm goal of reaching \$5,000. In fact, the final total of individual contributions was over \$9,000, almost doubling our initial goal!

Within two weeks, the firm raised over \$17,000 to aid the recovery efforts in the Gulf Coast. At the end of the program, the firm offered its gift of \$5,000 to the Salvation Army's National Capital Division .

Were it not for the generosity of the firm, and the compassion that J&C staff holds for its national community, this would not have been possible.
